## Holy Name 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Dance Rules

- 1 Anyone without a wrist ticket, a completed admission form and an ID will not be allowed in.
- 2 Only children in Grades 7/8 are allowed at the dance. **IDs will be checked. 6th grade students are invited to the last dance.**
- 3 We reserve the right to refuse admission to anyone.
- 4 **Chaperones have final say** on what is unacceptable behavior.
- 5 **Any child asked to leave the dance or handed over to the Boston Police for any reason will be banned from HN Dances.**
- 6 **There is a Zero Tolerance for Drug and Alcohol use.** Any child suspected of being under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs will be handed over to the Boston Police, a parent will be contacted, and **the offender will be banned from HN Dances.**
- 7 **There is a Zero Tolerance for Violence.** Any child involved in violent behavior will be handed to the Boston Police, a parent will be contacted, and **the offender will be banned from HN Dances.**
- 8 **Students will not be admitted to the dance wearing** tops, shirts or t-shirts with inappropriate sayings or that expose the stomach or back (such as bandana shirts, tube tops, etc.). Under garments must be covered. Skirts, dresses and shorts must be of appropriate length.  
Shorts or skirt length must be to the fingertips when arms are at side of body. Any shorts or skirt that is shorter will be unacceptable.  
No SWAG.  
After admittance, if a student alters her/his attire in a way that violates the dress code, the student will be removed and a parent called.  
Chaperones have the final say regarding appropriate dress.
- 9 **No smoking** in the dance or on Church property.
- 10 **No coats, jackets, sweatshirts, pocketbooks, backpacks or bags** of any kind are allowed. HNP is not responsible for any lost or stolen articles.
- 11 **No readmission** is allowed. *No refunds for any reason!*
- 12 **No inappropriate physical touching or dancing** will be tolerated.
- 13 **No foul or inappropriate language** will be tolerated.
- 14 **Anyone taking inappropriate pictures or pictures without the subject's consent** will have their phone confiscated for remainder of the dance. A parent must be present in order for it to be returned.

Any violation of the rules will result in being expelled from the dance. Anyone expelled will be banned from future Holy Name Dances.
